- Create a platform for community involvement and multi-stakeholder participation to guide an impact pathway of stakeholder processes

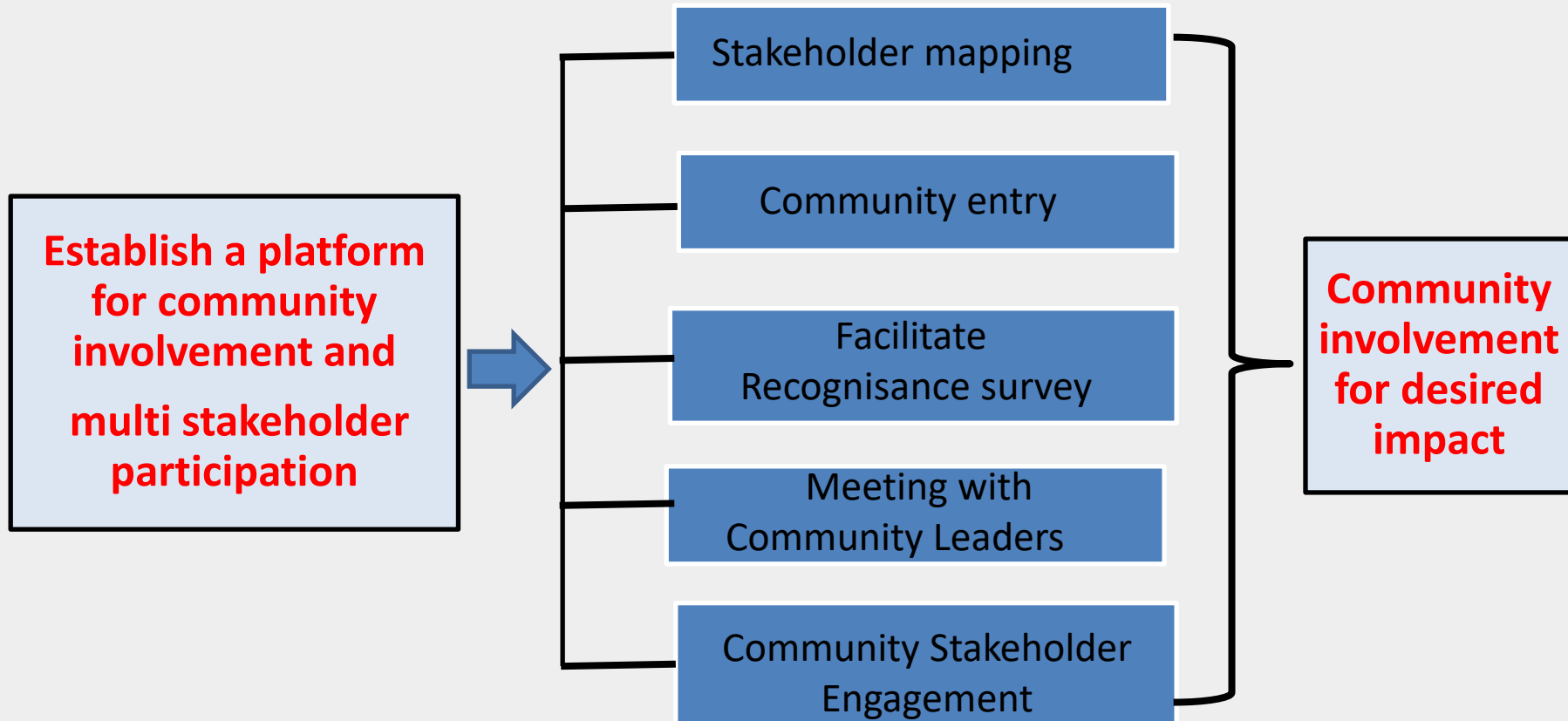
